

Announcement of the UMALCA Prize 2009

The Unión Matemática de América Latina y El Caribe invites nominations for the UMALCA Prize 2009 that will be awarded at the 3rd Latin American Congress of Mathematicians in Santiago de Chile (August 31 - September 4, 2009).

The UMALCA Prize was created in the year 2000 to distinguish the most brilliant young mathematicians working in the Latin American and Caribbean region, as well as to acknowledge and stimulate their contributions to Mathematics (more historical information on the prize can be obtained at the UMALCA official website www.umalca.org).

Nominations for the Prize must be made in English by filling the electronic form at http://3clam.umalca.org/?page_id=257

Candidates must work permanently in a Latin American country, and they must be less than 45 years old on the first day of the Congress at which the Prize is awarded.

The UMALCA Prize 2009 will distinguish up to 4 young latin-american mathematicians. In addition, to a monetary award equivalent to US\$2,500, it will include an invitation to give a Plenary Lecture at the 3rd Latin American Congress of Mathematicians.

The decision on the UMALCA Prize is the responsibility of Scientific Committee of the Congress. **The deadline for submitting nominations is May 31, 2009.**
